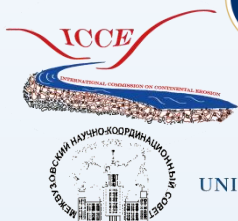

The international symposium on *River sediment quality and quantity: environmental, geochemical and ecological perspectives* continues the series of symposia organized under the auspices of the International Commission on Continental Erosion (ICCE), which is one of the ten commissions of the International Association of Hydrological Sciences (IAHS).

- Sediment quantity – cascades, budgets, yields
- Sediment impacts on river channel hydromorphology and management
- Sediment quality – geochemistry, nutrients, contaminants, emerging issues
- Sediment-biota interactions
- Business Day – Inland waterways development in Middle-East Europe

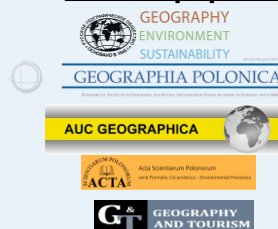


Registration fees
