The maximum award is €3200.

Local travel costs are normally small and involve using public transport to travel to/from international departure points, and between the accommodation and the conference venue

Make sure to explain the **Other** budget costs requested, e.g. travel insurance, Covid tests.

Accommodation cost is calculated as the number of nights of the meeting plus the night before and after, multiplied by the fixed rate depending on location. For this example, 4 nights are requested (24th, 25th during the conference + nights of 23rd and 26th before/after the conference) multiplied by €100 as the conference is in Europe = 4 x 100 = €400

Do not inflate your budget estimates to match exactly the maximum award amount. Reasonable costs will only be reimbursed when justified and supported by receipts.
